The Historic Highland Park Neighborhood Council (HHPNC) represents over 60,000 stakeholders who reside, own property, or conduct business in the community of Highland Park. On behalf of our stakeholders, we are submitting this letter of support for issuance of the police permit for Mr. T's Bowl located at 5621 N. Figueroa Street.

Issuance of the permit would transfer the bowling/café and entertainment/show permit to the 1933 Group, who plans to restore the exterior to its original 1960's façade, as well as the bowling sign and parapet. The interior restoration would include the eight existing lanes and improvements to provide live music, a full bar, and a restaurant.
